



A Tribute to the Legacy of Virginia Swartzendruber McQuail

Beloved wife, mother and grandmother, Virginia Swartzendruber McQuail is remembered by all those she touched with her love of volunteering and passion for social work.

Virginia was born in Kansas on December 11, 1917. Following high school and a Bachelor's degree from the University of Wisconsin, Virginia continued her passion for Social Work by receiving a Master's degree from the University of Michigan. Virginia's perseverance lead her to working for the Young Women's Christian Association while simultaneously obtaining her Master's degree. Her work at the YWCA continued until 1951 upon her marriage to husband Jim.

As she and Jim raised their family, Virginia served as a member of the Committee for International Visitors and continued working as a volunteer in many positions at the YWCA Chester County. Virginia's volunteering activities were diverse as she and Jim became involved with the Downingtown Area Interracial Coalition which formed following the assassination of Martin Luther King. She was also an active member of the Downingtown Friends Meeting (Quakers) and Valley Garden Club.

In lieu of flowers, the family asks that memorial donations be made to the YWCA Chester County Scholarship Fund which provides scholarships to women, primarily non-traditional students, to continue their education.
