Today, Lions Clubs International is the largest service organization in the world with 1.4 million members in 190 countries.

The West Goshen Lions Club was founded in February 1972. Today we are 60+ members strong. We are proud of the ethnic, religious, vocational, and age diversity of our members. We are a formidable team as we put into action the motto of Lions International: "We Serve."
