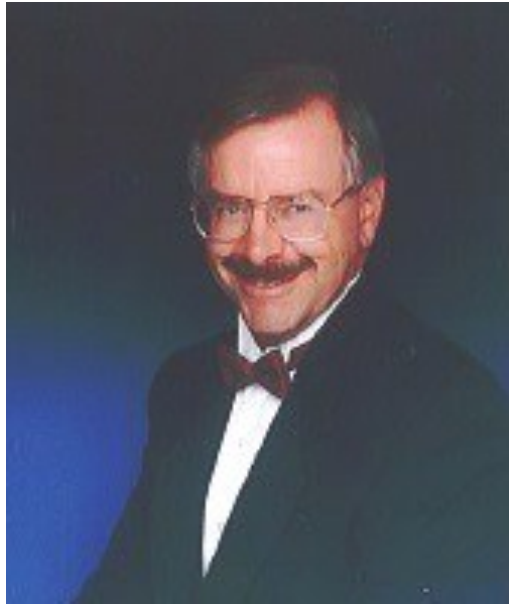




The Ruch Family Foundation Scholarship Fund

The Ruch Family Foundation has been established by Randy Ruch to provide educational scholarships to individuals attending post-secondary education, and grant funding to selected nonprofit organizations.



Educational scholarships support students from William Allen High School attending post-secondary education who meet defined academic and financial criteria. Students are selected by the Allentown School District Educational Foundation with the Scholarship Committee from William Allen High School.

Mr. Ruch is a former student of Franklin Elementary School, Raub Junior High School, and William Allen High School in the Allentown School District. He went on to complete undergraduate study at Villanova University and eventually founded Schuylkill Valley Sporting Goods. After growing the business to 19 stores in eastern Pennsylvania and dedicating 39 years to the industry, he was inducted into the Sporting Goods Industry Hall of Fame.
