Maria Whitehead was an incredible person who had a profound impact on everyone she met. She was an avid field hockey player throughout her life and after graduating from West Chester East High School in 1999, she went on to play field hockey for Wake Forest University. After guiding her team to the program's first national championship in 2002 she graduated from WFU in 2003 with a degree in communications. In 2003, Maria took the head coaching position at St. Louis University and led her team to their highest winning season since 1991. In that same season, Maria developed an unexplained pain in her hip which was diagnosed as melanoma. It eventually spread to her brain. Maria lost her battle with cancer at the young age of 25 on November 1st, 2006.

Maria touched the lives of many through her outgoing demeanor, her fun loving personality and her passion for the game of Field Hockey. The Maria Whitehead Memorial Scholarship Fund is committed to celebrating Maria's life and love of field hockey.
