Karrlin Field, known to all as Karrli, was an aspiring and talented writer of stories, poetry, and novels as well as a designer of imaginative and dramatic computer games. To learn more about Karrli, her works and her life, please visit www.karri.com.

Karrli was only 17 when she died of cystic fibrosis in 2004 but she left behind an impressive amount of creative work. Karrli's award honors her life, her creative works and her legacy by encouraging young women to follow their creative dreams, as Karrli would have wanted to. Karrli had always dreamed of attending the University of Advancing Technology in Tempe, Arizona. Her Memorial Scholarship Award provides financial support to female students who attend UAT, and who are pursuing a college education in computer game development and design.

ESSAY QUESTION:

Karrli's legacy encourages young women to follow their creative dreams. What are your creative and professional dreams and aspirations, and how do you plan to inspire other female gamers to reach for theirs? How would this award help you to continue your education and prepare for a career as a gamer?

For students under the age of 18 at date of entry, a parent or legal guardian must initial and sign this release. Students 18 or older at date of entry should initial and sign this form themselves.

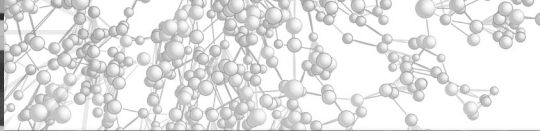

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GUIDELINES:

Award: A scholarship of \$1,000, once each semester (twice a year), to provide financial support towards tuition for women who attend the University of Advancing Technology in Tempe, Arizona.

Eligibility: Scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis to deserving students who in the judgment of the UAT Scholarship Committee best demonstrate the academic and creative qualifications needed to succeed in the field of computer game development and design. The Scholarship Committee will consider the academic performance and financial need of scholarship applicants.

Requirements: Applicant must be a current UAT female resident gamer with a cumulative High School GPA of 3.0 or higher or a cumulative college GPA of 3.0 or higher who also demonstrates financial need.

Essay Format: Submissions must be the original, unpublished work of the applicant. Minimum 500 words. Scholarship applications can be submitted to: UAT Scholarship Committee ATTN: Michelle Kable, AcceptanceOffice@uat.edu

SCHOLARSHIP DISTRIBUTION

- Award recipients will be named in July for the Fall semester and December for the Spring semester and notified by email and letter.
- Scholarship winners must send in proof of their matriculation during the fall semester at UAT to receive scholarship funds, no later than December.
- The Award check is made out to the student and the institution, and the funds are posted by UAT to the student's account to use for tuition, housing, books, etc.
- The Award check will be distributed by the end of each semester.
