WHAT IS A COMMUNITY FOUNDATION?

Established in 1994, the Community Foundation builds community assets for perpetuity. The Community Foundation is entrusted with substantial amounts of money over time from the contributions of people of significant wealth and modest means. The Community Foundation uses the income from these funds, in the form of grants, to meet the community's charitable needs now and into the future.

Most of the funds at the Community Foundation are endowment funds. An endowment fund is a permanent fund that creates a sustainable flow of grant dollars forever. Through prudent investment, both the body of the endowment and the distribution available for grantmaking increase over time.

The Chester County Community Foundation has three unique features:

local expertise about important projects and programs that are making a significant difference in Chester County

personalized service to donors who want to maximize the impact of their contribution; and

community convener for issues that benefit from partnerships.

With the support of those who care about Chester County, we will continue to grow and enhance the quality of life for all who live and work in Chester County.

THE POWER OF *legacy philanthropy*

While the world braced itself and endured difficult economic times in 2009, we at the Community Foundation were heartened to see that our base of support came through strongly. In an encouraging sign of the goodness of humankind, generosity prevailed when people needed it most.

This year, the Community Foundation awarded \$1,555,352 to the community, via 382 grants and 129 scholarships. Our donors created 28 new funds this year, which is more than the number created last year. This brings the total number of funds under the Community Foundation's umbrella to 288. And although our total donation dollar level was lower, the number of donations was higher. 3,962 generous donors contributed \$3.0 million to our family of funds--this is a 45% increase in the number of donors. More people gave somewhat more modest amounts, while our base of support diversified and grew.

Planned giving and bequests increased, due to the Community Foundation's ever-growing relationships with planned giving professional advisors and the long-term commitment of generous legacy donors.

The Community Foundation also initiated research to become more proactive with younger philanthropists. The Next Generation Task Force will increase charitable involvement, grantmaking, and legacy fund creation by more effectively engaging people aged 25-45 in philanthropy. Co-chaired by Meghan McVety and Richard Clark, you will see more of this initiative as pilot programs launch during 2010.

We thank each of our fund advisors and fund donors for their generosity. We are also grateful to those who contributed to the Community Foundation's own annual fund via our Sweet Charity event at Waterloo Gardens, our Charity Golf Outing at Hartefeld, and our annual Friends campaign. We also developed new partnerships with our premiere issue of Exclusively Chester County, our highly respected publication which features Chester County's finest businesses with a social conscience.

Why do individuals, families, nonprofits and community groups increasingly turn to the Community Foundation? In addition to customized, personal service and local expertise, the Community Foundation works with each of its fund donors to:

- focus charitable goals, values and mission
- understand where charities fit into the world, and what they accomplish
- learn more about community issues
- select high-performing charities that meet each fund donor's interests and priorities; and
- make grants to help improve the community in areas that are important to each individual.



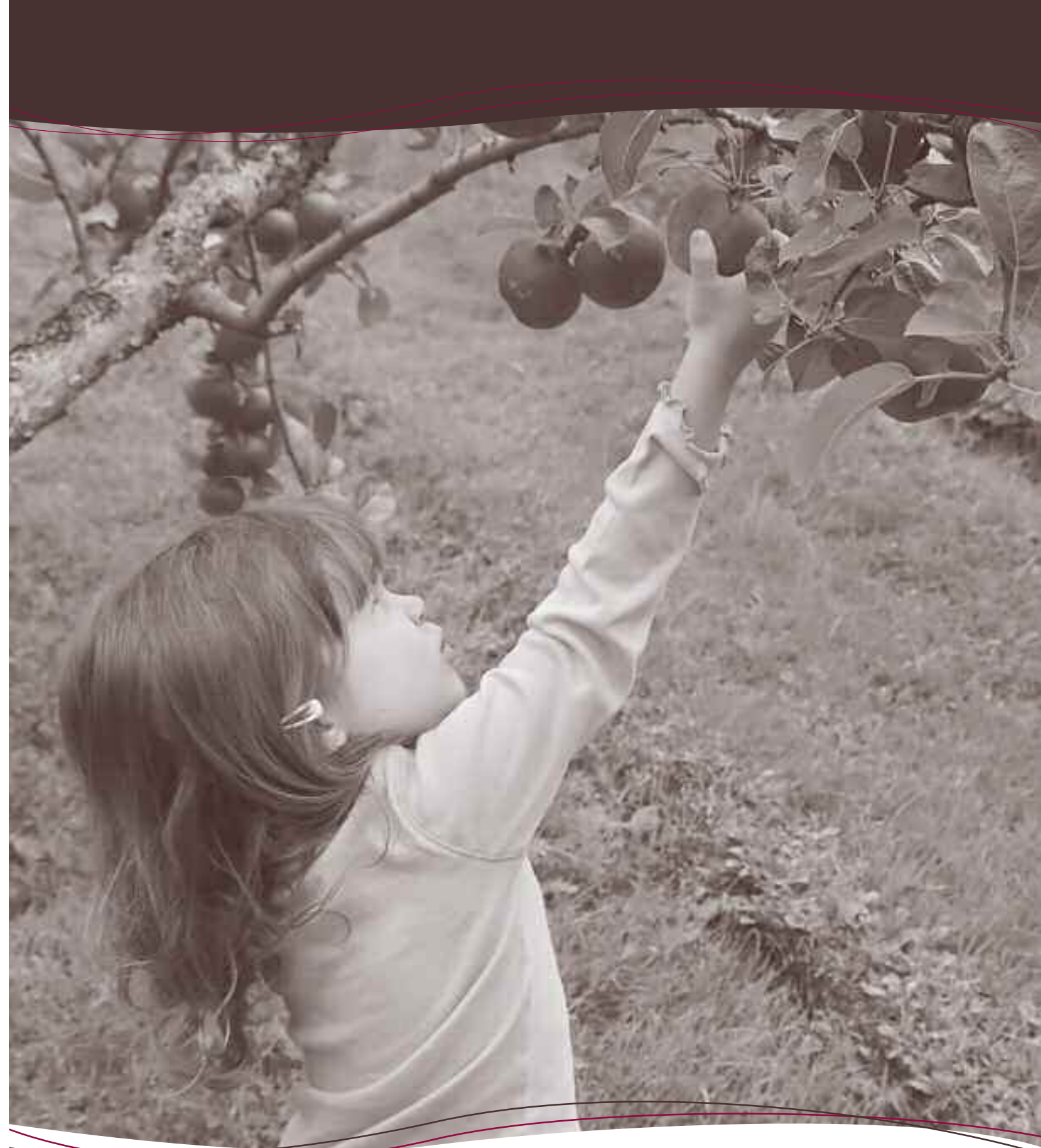

Grants, Scholarships & Awards

The strength of the Chester County Community Foundation is in its power to change peoples' lives. Each year, hundreds of organizations—and thousands of people—are touched through the generosity of our donors.

Our donors establish grantmaking funds at the Community Foundation. The majority of grant decisions are made by the families and individuals whose funds the Community Foundation hold in trust. The Community Foundation also grants a modest amount from its Fund for Chester County, based on decisions made by a volunteer Grants Committee. The typical grant size averages \$3,500.

During FY2009, \$1,555,352 in grants and scholarships were awarded this year to address needs in our community: 382 grants totaling \$1,413,765 and 129 scholarships totaling \$141,587.

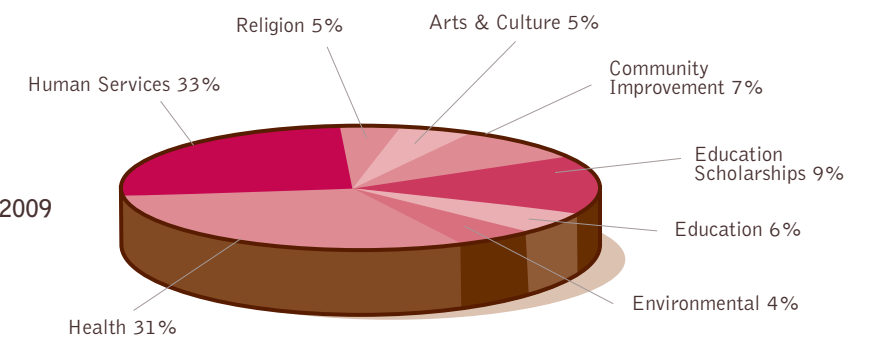

Philanthropy Awards

The Chester County Community Foundation established "Let Your Legacy Make A Difference Awards" to highlight philanthropic good works and inspire more throughout Chester County. Philanthropy is defined as "active efforts to promote human welfare as manifested in donations of money, property, or work to needy persons or to socially useful purposes." Legacy philanthropists give of their own time and resources, as well as inspire others to give for the long run.

CORPORATE SOCIAL INVESTMENT AWARD

~ Herr Foods

The Corporate Social Investment Award is conferred upon corporate leaders who demonstrate sound principles of business leadership and help the community prosper by consistently supporting local charities. J.M. Herr accepted this award on behalf of Herr Foods at the Foundation's annual meeting.

Herr Foods, headed by Jim, Ed and J.M. Herr, is an exemplary combination of business and social responsibility, consistently conducting business ethically, with a social conscience and devotion to community.

The Herr Foods story began in 1946 when 21 year old James Stauffer Herr bought a small potato chip company in Lancaster for \$1,750. From the beginning, Jim Herr adhered to his underlying business philosophy of providing quality products at competitive prices and backing them up with honesty and dependable service.

The Herr family has spread its corporate and personal philanthropy throughout Chester County, Lancaster County, Maryland and Delaware, involved with a wide array of local causes, especially in health, human services and religious outreach.

Jim Herr served as a director of the Chester County Development Council and as Building Campaign Chair for the Southern Chester County Health Services Medical Center. He was a 12-year member of the Oxford Area School Board, serving 5 of those years as its President. For 6 years, he held a seat on the Chester County Board of School Directors.

Ed Herr has served on the boards of numerous nonprofits, including the Oxford Chamber of Commerce, the Lighthouse Youth Center and the Oxford Senior Center.

J.M. has served in a leadership capacity on a wide variety of boards, including the International Bible Society. Most recently, J.M. served as Chair the Board of the Brandywine Valley YMCA as it began to undertake a large coordinated capital campaign.

Herr family members undertake significant leadership roles within their churches. They make a wide array of contributions to social service causes, many of which are religiously-based community outreach programs.

Herr Foods can always be counted on to contribute snack foods to any nonprofit. Furthermore, Herr Foods is the #1 donor in food volume to the Food Bank of Delaware. Herr Foods launched a clever marketing and charitable campaign with the release of chips repackaged in "His" bags for Father's Day. A "fun way to recognize Dads," proceeds from sales of the special edition chips benefited the National Fatherhood Initiative.

From humble beginnings, through many challenges and difficulties, Herr Foods has survived and prospered. The legacy that Jim and Miriam Herr have instilled within the next generations of leadership has become a solid foundation for the future.

~ West Chester University "Relay for Life"

The West Chester University Relay for Life brings together all aspects of campus and community to raise funds to benefit the local American Cancer Society. Teams are formed from academic clubs, residence halls, fraternities and sororities, service organizations, student government organizations, athletes and the community.

The 2008 24-hour Relay event involved 683 people, including cancer survivors. Speakers provided information and inspiration and entertainment abounded. West Chester University students contributed over 200,000 hours of service and raised \$63,000

for the American Cancer Society. The Relay was chaired by WCU students Lessie Cardinal and Bryn Finucane, with support from American Cancer Society staff member Julia Bonfante.

By bringing the students, employees and community together for the fight against cancer, exceptional rapport between campus and community was generated and set a foundation for future events.



DOOR OPENER AWARD

The Door Opener Award is bestowed upon a professional advisor who is an outstanding promoter of legacy philanthropy. By encouraging long-term charitable involvement, professional advisors are a crucial link in boosting legacy philanthropy.

John Featherman, a widely respected West Chester banker, attorney and community leader, has acted as this essential influential advocate. Philanthropy Awards

DR. HENRY A. AND BARBARA M. JORDAN AWARD

~ Carol Ware Gates, Ph.D.

The Community Foundation created the Jordan Award in 1999 to honor the philanthropy of Dr. Henry A. and Barbara M. Jordan of Chester Springs. The Jordan Award is bestowed annually to an individual who has made an enduring, long-term impact on a wide array of causes throughout Chester County; and through their leadership has given of their own time and resources, as well as inspired others to give for the long run.

The 2008 Jordan Award spotlights Carol Ware Gates' lifelong philanthropic achievements as a loyal friend of the region. Carol focuses her philanthropic leadership and social action in the areas of health, human services, education, environment, history, arts, culture and community building.

Carol Ware Gates grew up in Oxford and graduated from the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing with a B.S.N., R.N. After several years spent in Cleveland, Ohio and subsequently Boise, Idaho, Carol returned to Pennsylvania in 1986. She has dedicated her life to improving well-being in its many dimensions.

As President of the 1675 Foundation, Carol has made special efforts to develop the philanthropic impulse in her three children, encouraging them to volunteer and donate in their early years, and involving them strategically in the family foundation decisionmaking as early as possible.

Carol has made many of her philanthropic contributions anonymously, in an effort to maintain family privacy and fulfill her desire to undertake good works quietly. Her publicly known philanthropic accomplishments touch only the tip of a very generous iceberg.

In 2007, Carol received the President's Award for outstanding service to West Chester University. Among her numerous other awards are Arthritis Hero Award, the YMCA Volunteer of the Year, YMCA Triangle Club, and Chester County Education Foundation Award for work in special education. Carol serves on the Advisory Board for the Harvard School of Divinity. In 2008, Carol received the University of Pennsylvania 2008 Alumni Award of Merit.

Carol takes humble pride in her role as a founding board member of the Chester County Community Foundation. Carol clearly understands and advocates for the unique role community foundations play in building legacy philanthropy, so that people from all walks of life can make a difference in their communities, now and forever. In 2006, in recognition of her stellar service, Carol was named an Emeritus Board Member of the Community Foundation. In 2008 she agreed to serve as Honorary Co-Chair for the Community Foundation's "Campaign for Independence II," and in the first year quiet phase of the campaign, Carol assisted in doubling the endowment.

In addition to her many accomplishments, Carol has provided wise counsel to scores of community organizations. Through her actions she has been a tireless advocate of public service, creating a permanent legacy of philanthropy that has touched thousands of lives. Carol Ware Gates has remembered her Chester County roots, and she has chosen to stay committed for a lifetime of philanthropic good works.

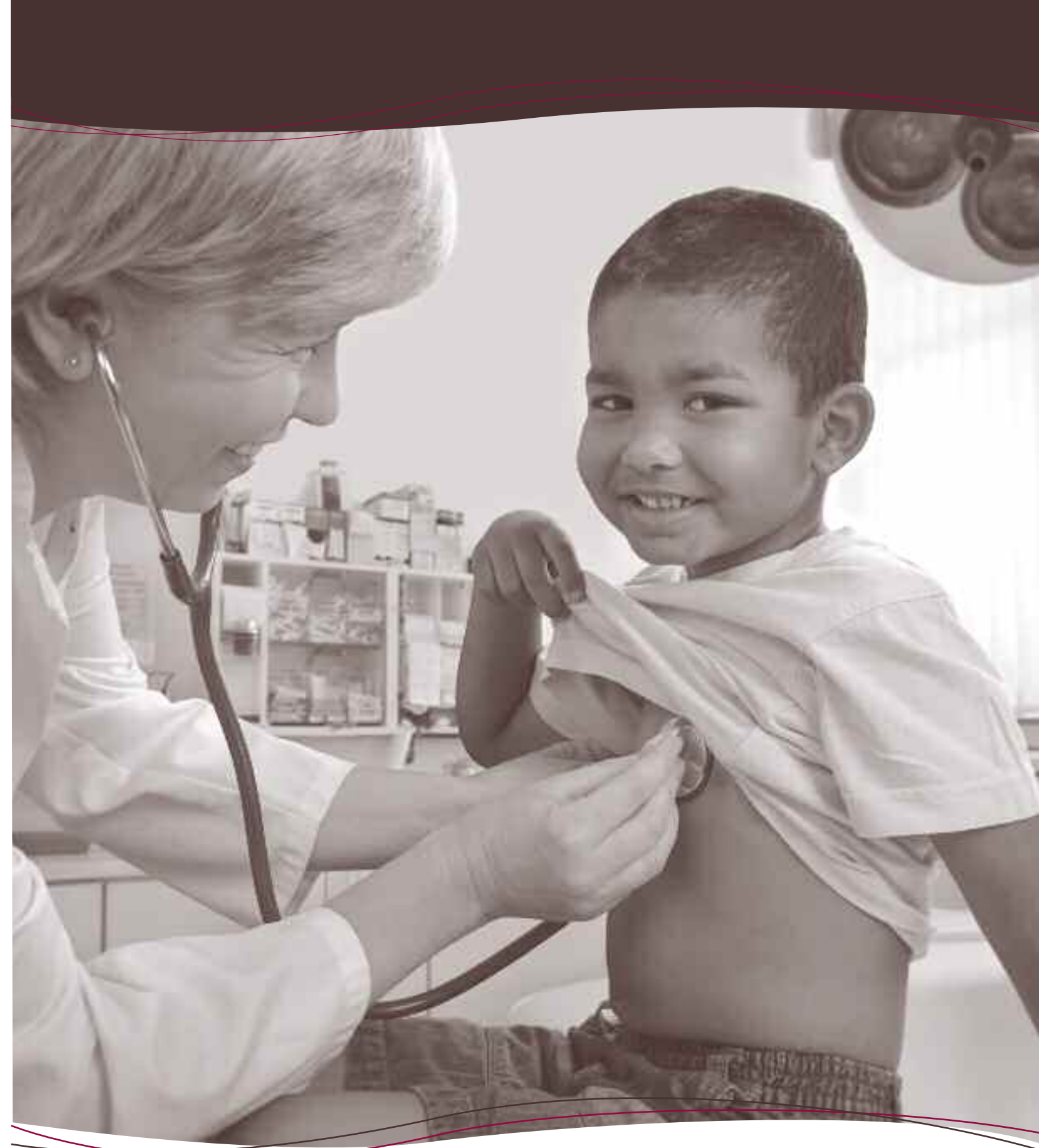

Legacy Funds

WHAT LEGACY WILL YOU LEAVE?

Legacy philanthropy is much more than sending a check. It ensures your continuing support for causes you care about, in perpetuity. It gives you the opportunity to carry on a family giving legacy. And, combined with careful estate planning, it ensures that your personal resources are used to accomplish your financial and charitable goals.

Gifts to the Community Foundation can be made at any time to provide grants for current community needs and for perpetuity. By establishing a fund with the Community Foundation, you receive:

- **Permanence:** The Community Foundation's trusteeship ensures that your contribution will continually meet needs relevant to your interests.
- **Commemoration:** Your name or the name of a loved one can live on through your fund. If you prefer, you may choose a name that reflects your fund's charitable purpose.
- **Stewardship:** The Foundation's Board of Directors, with guidance from its Investment Committee, staff, and outside investment counsel, closely monitors the performance of professional investment managers. The Foundation makes a full accounting to the community through its annual report, audit, and IRS Form 990.

■ **Grantmaking Expertise:** The Community Foundation can expertly assist you in identifying charitable organizations and programs that address your particular interests.

The Community Foundation primarily holds endowed funds in trust, and also manages some provisional funds.

- **Endowed Funds** are allowed a 5% grant payout for perpetuity, to assure that grant funds are always available to help nonprofits.
- **Quasi-Endowed Funds** are allowed a 20% grant payout, which means the principle will be decreased over time.
- **Provisional Funds** can be paid out in full at any time.

Grants awards are made to bona fide nonprofit causes throughout the United States.

TYPES OF FUNDS

Fund for Chester County

This fund focuses on making grants to Chester County nonprofits in areas of greatest need, as targeted by the Grants Committee of the Foundation. Donations of any size are welcome to this fund at any time.

Field of Interest

Donors who seek to impact a targeted issue area (arts, education, environment, health, human service, religion) or specific geographic region establish Field of Interest Funds. By naming an interest area rather than a specific organization, flexibility exists to meet ever-changing needs.

Donor Advised

An alternative to a private foundation, Donor Advised Funds are popular with donors who wish to establish a Foundation without incurring administrative operating and compliance filing burdens, while capitalizing on the Community Foundation's philanthropy expertise and nonprofit field research. Donor Advised Funds enable individuals, families, community groups, and businesses to focus their philanthropy and make grants that impact the causes they care about most.

Scholarship

Establishing a Scholarship Fund allows the donor to benefit students pursuing education beyond high school. A donor may name the scholarship's selection committee and the guidelines for candidate selection. Most scholarships at the Community Foundation benefit disadvantaged, promising students from a particular high school, or those who pursue a particular field of study.

Memorial Fund

Donors can quickly and cost-effectively create commemorative funds honoring people they hold dear.

Organizational Endowment and Non profit-Designated Funds

Designated Funds are created by nonprofit organizations and individual donors who care about the long-term success of a particular nonprofit charity. This lets donors support specific organizations while the Community Foundation manages investments professionally and monitors for accountability.

LIFETIME GIFTS

Your charitable interests can be supported during your lifetime—and in perpetuity—through your gift. You will have the satisfaction of seeing your generosity at work as you carry out your charitable objectives.

FUTURE GIFTS

The Community Foundation can work with you to articulate your wishes for a gift that would commence after your lifetime. The Community Foundation accepts most planned giving vehicles, including charitable gift annuities, bequests, retirement fund assets and life insurance. If you decide to leave a planned gift to the Community Foundation, or to a fund at the Community Foundation, please let us know so that we can properly carry out your wishes.

Fund highlights

THE HONORABLE DR. CLIFFORD E. DEBAPTISTE FAMILY OF FUNDS

“Uplifting life through service” is the theme for the life led by Dr. DeBaptiste. It is also the slogan for his business. Due to his grace, Chester County residents have been uplifted for decades and decades.

The young Clifford first visited West Chester in the 1940’s when he visited his Aunt Louise. Through his frequent visits, he began a lifetime love affair with the town, vowing to return and open up his own business. Young, energetic and ambitious, he returned in 1954 after having served in the U.S. Army, graduating from mortuary school, and marrying Inez Manning. He and Inez opened the DeBaptiste Funeral Home that year. The business prospered, and they opened a new facility during the Great Blizzard of January 1965 at 601 E. Miner Street in West Chester, where it remains to this day.

In 1973, daughter Lillian DeBaptiste joined the family business. Inez and Lillian were the first mother-daughter team to simultaneously become funeral directors in Pennsylvania. They had a great run together for nearly two decades, until the beloved Inez passed away in 1990.

The DeBaptiste family lives and works in the heart of the West Chester community, serving their neighbors at the most sensitive of times. As funeral directors, their service creates an atmosphere authentic to each life, evoking the fondest of memories and bringing comfort and joy to hurting hearts.

Dr. DeBaptiste found that many people want to create a legacy on behalf of their departed family members. Dr. DeBaptiste personally establishes scholarship funds and also introduces families and friends to the Community Foundation. Education and scholarship funds are his hallmark. To celebrate his tenure as Mayor of West Chester, the Mayor Clifford E. DeBaptiste Scholarship was created to annually provide tuition support to a West Chester University freshman majoring in social work. The Dr. W.T.M. Johnson Memorial Scholarship awards annual scholarships to Henderson High School students. The Dr. Robert H. and Doris E. Hanna Scholarship is given to students graduating from a Chester County high school. The Alice M. Thomas Scholarship Fund pays homage to the work of this extraordinary Henderson High School guidance counselor. And Stanley’s Dream Scholarship was initiated by Dr. DeBaptiste to honor a promising youth’s life that was too short-lived. These endowed scholarships make a difference forever and help Chester County students pursue their dreams, well-equipped with a college education.

Dr. DeBaptiste holds lifetime memberships in four branches of the NAACP. He has received four gubernatorial appointments, including as a member and Vice President of the Board of Trustees of West Chester University. Since 1975, he has also served on the Board of Directors of First National Bank of Chester County.

Yet his service goes far beyond Chester County. In 2009 alone, Dr. DeBaptiste was recognized by the National Purple Heart Association for his service in the U.S. Army during the 1940s and the Korean War; by the NAACP for his years as a business leader; and honored with the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Sunrise Rotary Club of West Chester. He also received his 33rd degree and final degree of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, a distinction shared by President Bill Clinton and Colin Powell. Overall, Dr. DeBaptiste has been recognized with over 400 awards and citations throughout the years.

Dr. DeBaptiste has served on the State Board of Funeral Directors for the Commonwealth, and he was elected Chair of the Board 13 times. He is also one of the few people to be President of the Pennsylvania Funeral Directors Association and simultaneously Chair of the State Board of Funeral Directors. He is the first Association President from Chester County. He holds memberships in all local, county, state and national funeral director associations, traveling frequently to fulfill his obligations. In 2009, Dr. DeBaptiste celebrated marked his professional service by creating three donor advised funds on behalf of his professional associations. “It is important to demonstrate to funeral directors that there are tangible ways they can become involved in strengthening their communities. These three perpetual funds will allow the funeral director associations to make charitable grants to causes that are important to them and their communities.”

Dr. DeBaptiste is a model of community legacy philanthropy. He consistently helps others to find ways to commemorate those they hold dear, and makes a positive difference in numerous lives for perpetuity. Uplifting life through service...creating a strong community...forever.

FRANCIS J. SNYDER FOUNDATION – established 2007

Francis J. Snyder (“Fritz”) has spent his life in a small city nestled in dairy country in central New York, living a very solid, simple life.

Fritz was the product of a faith- and love-filled Catholic home. His Dad was a factory worker and his Mom a homemaker. Fritz learned about sharing from day one. While his parents “made do” with what they were blessed with, he watched, learned and appreciated. Fritz’s mom made fried cakes every Saturday morning. It could not have been a coincidence that the paperboy “collected” every Saturday just as those fried cakes were being shaken in a bag of powdered sugar. The paperboy was always invited in and treated to a doughnut.

Grandma Snyder had a brother who during the Depression was in danger of losing his home to taxes. Grandma somehow found a way to take care of the tax bill and preserve her brother’s home and dignity. Grandpa Snyder worked hard and was never out of work. Grandma Snyder worked hard at home and found ways to stretch her family’s budget including some years seeing that her brother’s coal bin was filled for the cold winter. Grandma used to say that she would walk the length of Main Street to save a nickel. More on that “saved nickel” to follow.

At 18, Fritz started working at the same factory where his own Dad was employed. At 28, he married his sweetheart and life partner, Loretta Ryan. Together they built their own faith-and love-filled family. They brought 9 children into the world and so far have celebrated 61 anniversaries together. They are proud of their 31 grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren.

Loretta was born and raised on a farm near a small village 30 miles from Fritz. Farm life was tough. The Ryan family always had a wholesome dinner on the table through her parent’s hard work and ingenuity; but there was not much left over after the basic necessities were met. When Fritz and Loretta married, Loretta herself did not realize how difficult it was for her own dear mother, recently widowed and with young children at home. Fritz and Loretta began sending her mother money when they had a bit extra. This may have been the beginning of Fritz and Loretta’s charity work together.

In the early years of their family, somehow Fritz and Loretta managed to sponsor a seminarian, Father Joseph Arackaparambil, a Catholic priest in Kerala, India.



Fritz and Loretta valued Catholic education and saw to it that their children attended Catholic School. Fritz himself entered St. Mary’s School the first year it opened – 1928 – and all nine Snyder children went there, as well as 13 of the 31 grandkids.

Back to that “saved nickel”. Fritz has always gotten a tremendous amount of pleasure out of giving; yet he never had a large coffer from which to give. In New York State it is law that carbonated beverages have a nickel deposit attached. Fritz began collecting castaway cans and bottles and returning them for the cash. What has he received from this endeavor? Fritz gets a tremendous amount of exercise from walking, and he has several favorite charities to which he donates the proceeds of those castaway nickels! He has collected thousands of nickels and given away hundreds and hundreds of dollars. He has “walked the length of Main Street” to save a nickel and he has exemplified his own dear mom’s generosity.

After Fritz and Loretta lost their son, Gary, in a car accident in 1979, they started a memorial scholarship in Gary Snyder’s name at St. Mary’s School. Years later the existence of that scholarship gave Tom (the ninth) and Alicia an idea. They saw the joy that Fritz received from giving and they wanted to help him to do what he really enjoys.

The Francis J. Snyder Foundation at the Chester County Community Foundation was born. Tom explains “My dad is a humble, happy, and content man. He doesn’t have a lot of wants. His needs are met. He gets such joy out of giving to his charities. Why not help him give now, instead of giving in his name, later?”

Each year Tom and Alicia give Pops a handful of grant distribution forms for his August 1st birthday and ask him to make his gift-giving choices. Pops loves to be able to make a difference with generosity. Tom adds “It’s the best present we could give him!”

Fritz and Loretta now spend their summers in a cozy home on Tully Lake in New York. (Fritz likes to say he helped his sons build it, but of course HE built it with some help from his sons.) They enjoy winters in Florida. Wherever they are, Tully or Florida, Fritz makes it a point to attend daily Mass. The Snyder children and their spouses are all in awe of the faith-filled life their parents have enjoyed together and the generosity that they have always practiced.

Charitable Fund Investment Partners Program

WHAT IS THE CHARITABLE FUND INVESTMENT PARTNERS PROGRAM?

The Charitable Fund Investment Partners Program is a collaboration between wealth managers, investment advisors, and financial advisors and the Community Foundation.

This program gives you the opportunity to establish a donor-advised fund at the Community Foundation, while having a qualified advisor you choose continue to manage the asset and receive investment management fees.

Consider the Charitable Fund Investment Partners Program if you want:

- a simple, flexible way to make strategic, long-term tax-deductible charitable contributions
- your charitable fund to be invested by a qualified advisor of your choice.

HOW CAN YOU GET STARTED?

- To establish your donor-advised fund, you sign an agreement with the Chester County Community Foundation. Your advisor is not party to this agreement.
- The minimum amount to start a donor-advised fund in the Charitable Fund Investment Partners program is \$250,000. (The minimum for non-investment partner program funds is \$10,000.)
- The Community Foundation's Investment Committee undertakes due diligence on your advisor. Your advisor is expected to follow the Community Foundation's Investment Policy.
- Your charitable fund's investment returns are NOT aggregated with other Community Foundation funds.
- Your charitable fund will be charged a slightly higher administrative fee by the Community Foundation (25 basis points higher than the aggregated fee schedule); plus your advisor's investment management fees.
- Your advisor's investment process and performance is reviewed by the Community Foundation's Investment Committee quarterly.
- Your charitable gift is irrevocable. After the gift is made, the assets become the legal property of CCCF. You recommend grant distributions from the fund. Per IRS regulations, the Community Foundation has final approval on all grant recommendations.
- The Community Foundation retains the legal right to terminate the relationship with your advisor, especially if you as the founding contributor cease your relationship with that advisor.

It all adds up to a winning formula: you supply the charitable passion, your financial advisor supplies the investment expertise, and the Community Foundation supplies the charitable legacy vehicle. All get credit for the perfect charitable solution.

Investment Management

The Community Foundation is committed to prudent investment management strategies and fiscal policies that it believes will lead to the long-term growth of endowment fund principal and enable the Community Foundation to successfully meet its spending policy objectives.

The Community Foundation's investment goal is to maximize total return in any combination of its income components (interest and dividends) and capital appreciation while carefully weighing the risks involved. This total return approach provides the fewest constraints on investment managers and, therefore, puts the Community Foundation in a better position to demand superior investment performance results.

The Community Foundation desires a target return that provides portfolio growth, exceeds inflation, covers investment fee expenses, covers the Community Foundation's 1% administrative fee, and covers the annual grant payout of 5% (5% of the previous fiscal year end balance) on an annual basis over a market cycle. In addition, the Foundation seeks to protect the principal value of the originally invested endowment assets, while recognizing that prudent risks must be taken.

The Community Foundation's Investment Committee is comprised of community leaders with extensive investment experience, who volunteer their time and expertise to make sure our funds realize their optimum return. The Investment Committee oversees the performance of portfolio investment managers. They include:



Hirtle, Callaghan & Co. serves as the Community Foundation's Chief Investment Officer. Hirtle Callaghan, as managing fiduciary, works with the Community Foundation to develop a formal Investment Policy Statement and Investment Plan designed to best meet the Community Foundation's objectives.

Hirtle Callaghan is responsible and accountable for two major objectives. The first is to work with the Community Foundation's Board and Investment Committee to structure a long-term strategic asset allocation plan with asset class targets and operating ranges and to deliver strategic proactive guidance on asset class and portfolio risks. The second mandate is to identify, evaluate, select and monitor and terminate investment managers, manage fund flows and manager allocations on a full-time basis. Hirtle Callaghan will then implement the broadly diversified investment program within the approved stated guidelines through independent specialist money managers. Additionally, Hirtle Callaghan is also responsible for retaining and directing the activities of the custodian, and all other vendors involved in providing data, analysis and other services used to manage the portfolio. Finally, Hirtle Callaghan provides monthly statements and performance reports, net of all fees, on a quarterly basis with comparisons to relevant benchmarks and peer groups.

As a firm, Hirtle Callaghan's first investment objective is to protect principal. Hirtle Callaghan's second investment objective is to significantly out-perform inflation net of all fees. Hirtle Callaghan's third investment objective is to achieve attractive returns relative to appropriate benchmarks and manager peer groups.

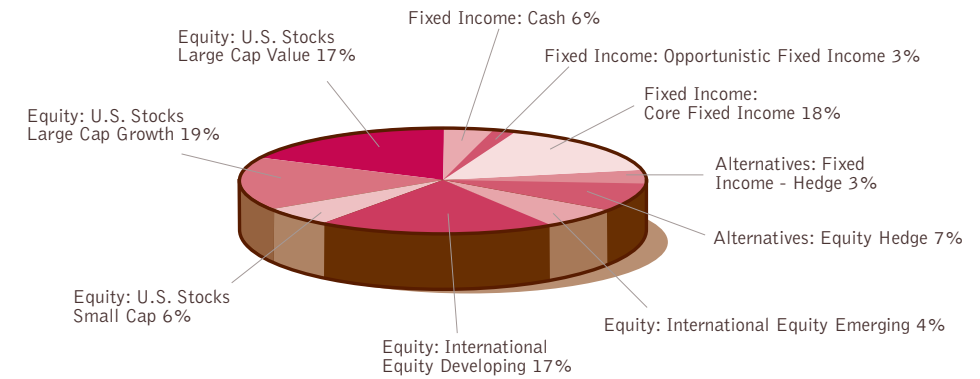
