On June 28, 2017, 18-year old Bianca Nikol Roberson was driving home after a shopping trip with her mother and grandmother, and the unthinkable happened. Bianca was shot in the head, a random victim of road rage and racial intolerance. This recently graduated Bayard Rustin High School senior was dead, never to attend her much-anticipated Jacksonville University, major in psychology, nor play basketball ever again. This horrific assault made headlines around the world, shaking people to their core.

Sadly, death was not new to the family. Mykel James Rowley, Bianca's brother, died from muscular dystrophy-related heart disease on October 24, 2013 at age 22. A Bayard Rustin High School graduate, Mykel attended Indiana University of PA and worked with CR England Trucking Company driving tractor-trailers, a life-long goal.
