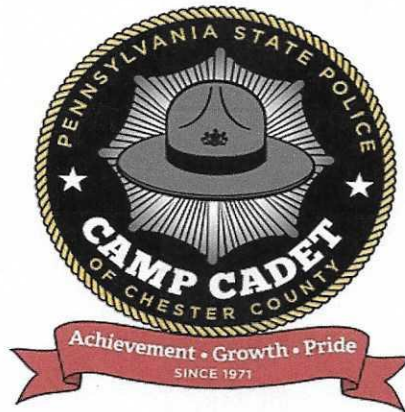

The Chester County Camp Cadet Program is a week long, overnight summer camp sponsored by the Pennsylvania State Police for Chester County Children ages 11-13, offered at no cost to their families. In addition to the fun activities of a typical summer camp, such as swimming, fishing, canoeing, and sporting events, the Chester County Camp Cadet program introduces these impressionable young people to the Law Enforcement community in a very positive way. They interact daily, with Troopers who serve as camp counselors. While at camp, the young men and women are introduced to various aspects of Law Enforcement and Emergency Services through demonstrations on areas including patrol, criminal investigation, forensics, drug enforcement, K-9 units, aviation, bicycles units, bomb squads and tactical units. This allows them to gain a better understanding of how, and why police officers do what they do. Most importantly, this interaction gives children the opportunity to see that police officers are approachable, caring individuals who are dedicated to protecting them, while providing service within their communities. This is not a forced-discipline type camp, or "boot camp". Although, modeled after the Pennsylvania State Police Academy, wholesome family and societal values and standards are emphasized. Our program is designed to be fun for the children. During the experience, children participate in team building and conflict resolution activities and are positively-encouraged to develop; respect for themselves and for others, self-discipline, and confidence. Children may attend only once, unless selected as an "outstanding cadet", and asked to return as a "junior counselor". The only eligibility requirement is that the children reside in Chester County.

Our program is currently supported financially, by organizations, such as the Whitford Charitable Fund of Chester County Community Foundation, Philadelphia Electric Company, Herr Foods and various organizations and individuals as well as an annual golf fund raising event.

We continually reach out to other organizations to ensure that this program continues well into the future. All support is gratefully appreciated.
