

Covid-19 Reopening Plan for The Oxford Arts Alliance

What rules will be enforced by the OxAA?

- Maintaining social distancing (staying six feet away from others)
- Reduced sharing of common spaces and frequently touched objects
- All visitors **MUST** wear masks.
- Faculty must clean instruments with disinfectant after each student
- If symptomatic, stay home
- Contact such as shaking hands, high-fives, etc is not allowed.

How will the OxAA be cleaning our building?

The Oxford Arts Alliance will be following the **Guidance for Cleaning & Disinfecting Tool** from the CDC (See Attached I.)

Additionally, we will be using ONLY [EPA-approved disinfectants against COVID-19](#) while cleaning our building.

Our guidance on HOW to clean our building will come from the [CDC's website on Cleaning and Disinfection for Community Facilities](#).

Additional guidance for the use of disinfectants will be executed via guidance from the EPAs **Disinfectant Onepager** (See attached III.)

How is the OxAA protecting its staff and faculty?

Staff will be provided with appropriate PPE for use when inside the OxAA. Additionally, equipment such as gloves, masks, and other protections will be provided to cleaning staff when cleaning or disinfecting inside the building.

Where is the OxAA getting its guidance for reopening its facility?

We are following the CDCs **Reopening America Guidance** packet (see attached II.) for guidance and strategies in making the reopening of our facility as safe as possible.

What procedures will the OxAA take to ensure the building is safe before reopening?

The OxAA will be following the CDCs [Guidance for Reopening Buildings after Shutdown](#) to ensure a safe water system and more during our reopening process.

Self-Check Protocol for Students

Before coming to lessons...

1. Take your temperature.

Q: What is considered a fever?

A: The CDC defines a fever as having a measured temperature of 100.4 °F [38 °C]

2. Take a Self-Check of your symptoms

Q: How do I know if my symptoms keep me from coming to lessons?

3. Check for all of the necessary PPE that you'll need (face mask, etc)

When entering your lesson...

1. Be sure your mask is on and maintain social distancing from others at all times.

During your lessons...

1. Please use the empty art gallery on the 1st floor with designated seating 6 feet apart when waiting for your lessons. (the art gallery is located one door over from the academy entrance.)

Self Check Protocol for Faculty

Before coming to work...

- 1. Take your temperature.**

- 2. Take a Self-Check of your symptoms**

- 3. Check for all of the necessary PPE that you'll need (face mask, gloves)**

When entering the building...

- 1. Sign in on the personalized sign-in board that is posted in your studio.**

- 2. Make sure you are wearing your PPE.**

During your lessons...

- 1. Continually wipe down any surface touched by a student with a disinfecting wipe.**

- 2. Keep students from touching surfaces such as light switches, windows, or any surface that is not essential to their lesson.**

When you are leaving the building...

- 1. Wipe down any surfaces that need to be disinfected.**

- 2. Sign out on the personalized board that is posted in your studio.**
