

#### So far our efforts have led to:

- hundreds of millions of dollars of equitably distributed public education funding;
- increased wages and collective bargaining power for hundreds of airport workers;
- a livable minimum wage in the City of Philadelphia; and
- citizen-led police oversight.

Currently POWER organizes around issues related to education, climate, criminal justice, and economic dignity.
