THE PURPOSE of The Jeremy P. Wilson Foundation is to honor Jeremy's love of learning by enabling other students to pursue higher education, and his love of life by helping to promote and fund childhood cancer research, giving other children better treatment options and HOPE for a cure.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Scholarships are awarded to deserving male or female students who, in the judgment of The Jeremy P. Wilson Foundation Scholarship Committee, best meet the following criteria:

- Student is a childhood cancer survivor or is currently in cancer treatment.
- Student has lost an immediate family member, e.g. parent, primary caregiver, or sibling to cancer or has endured their cancer treatment.
- Student must be planning to attend a 4 year college or university or 2 year community college program.
- Student must demonstrate that he or she has performed regular community service throughout his or her high school career.
- Student may include any other special circumstances which are pertinent to his or her candidacy, i.e. financial need, family situation, GPA, academic successes and/or challenges, etc.
