
CORNERJAWN'S FIRST LOCATION



Vision

FarmerJawn & Friends Foundation Fund's vision is to improve Philadelphia's social, environmental, and physical health. With a pro-Black and inclusive approach, we seek to reimagine the way the city uses land. We bring regenerative organic agriculture practices and education to urban communities, helping people understand the farm to food connection through organic foodways.

Environmental

The quality of the water we drink, the air we breathe, and the food we eat are all linked by one overlooked factor: our soil.

Regenerative organic farming revitalizes our soil, our crops, our food, and therefore our people.

Physical

Our food system has disrupted the connection between food and farming. Farmer's markets can bridge the gap, but they often geographically exclude Black and Brown populations, especially those living in poverty. These communities deserve the farm to table connection so often afforded to their white and wealthy neighbors.

HEALTHY FOOD = HEALTHY PEOPLE

Social

Organic food is not a privilege; it is a human right. Marginalized groups have the poorest health outcomes and the highest rate of gun violence. In the face of these issues, each compounded by systemic racism, urban agriculture is a vector of hope. Access to healthy food, environments bettered by healthy soil and crops, and the community built around local farms can revitalize urban communities.
