- a deep-rooted commitment to social justice led to a strong anti-slavery movement and women's right to vote.

JUNETEENTH CELEBRATION

CULTURE BUILDS COMMUNITY

When the Founding Fathers signed the Declaration of Independence in July 1776, they knew there would be unfinished business. The second paragraph of the Declaration reads, "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal..."

However, enslaved people and women had no voting rights and little to no property rights. The unalienable Rights of Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness were not self-evident for all.


Nearly 100 years later, from 1861-1865 the American Civil War was fought, primarily over the long-standing disagreement over slavery. Although President Lincoln's January 1, 1863 Emancipation Proclamation was issued during the war, it had little to no impact on enslaved people's freedom in Southern states, as it couldn't be enforced.

Juneteenth, or June 19th, is the anniversary of the day that commemorates the end of slavery in the U.S., when General Granger arrived in Galveston TX and freed 250,000 enslayed Black Americans: 2% years after the Emancipation Proclamation and 2 months after the Civil War ended.

In 2021, President Biden signed the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act into law establishing Juneteenth as a federal holiday. The Community Foundation fosters Juneteenth commemorations throughout the region. Juneteenth organizers from Coatesville, Kennett Square, Lincoln University, Phoenixville and West Chester convene monthly, to plan





- Serve on a jury when called upon.
- Defend the country if the need should arise.




