Door Opener Award

BARBER FAMILY LEGACY FUND FOR CHESTER COUNTY EST. 2023

Joseph A. Bellinghieri Esq., Door Opener Award

A mother raising a child with special needs while also owning and running a business is undeniably challenging. It requires significant dedication, resilience, and most of all, unconditional love.

Knowing her experience, Sue Miskevich Barber thought a lot about others who lived, and will live, her same journey. When it came time to do her estate planning, she made sure her legacy gift will help generations of mothers and families, forever.

Sue and her husband, Anthony “Tony” Barber, resided in Chester County for their entire lives. Born in 1919 and 1925, as part of the Greatest Generation, their coming-of-age experiences during the Great Depression and WWII shaped their values of hard work, dedication, commitment to country, community, and family.



After serving in U.S. General George Patton’s Third Army in the Battle of the Bulge, Tony returned home to the Malvern area and established his plumbing and heating business. He met the love of his life, Sue. After they were married, the hardworking couple both worked outside the home.

They persevered and saved enough money to establish their own business together. For over 40 years, they owned and operated the White House Inn at 1227 West Chester Pike in East Goshen Township. (This is the present-day site of The Stone Tavern.)

The restaurant was well known for its menu, including meatball sandwiches, wet roast beef entrées, and ice-cold beer. It was a place where neighbors met after bowling league night. It was also the site for countless bridal showers and wedding receptions. Owning the White House Inn required long hours and extra effort. The Barbers were rewarded with life-long friendships and lasting new connections.

In 1960 their son, Barry, was born. Barry had a very difficult life, faced with many physical and behavioral challenges. When it became impossible to care for Barry at home, over the



years he resided at several local long-term care and skilled nursing facilities. Though his limitations were numerous, Barry enjoyed a good Philadelphia sports game (Phillies, Eagles, Sixers, Flyers). He knew everything about John Deere power equipment.

After Tony died in 1996 at age 71, Barry remained Sue’s lifelong focus. To ensure Barry’s comfort and care for the long-term, Sue wished to establish a special needs trust. Sue knew she wanted the trust to be distributed to charity after Barry passed, but she was unsure how to structure this kind of specialized legacy gift.

Sue worked with Joseph Bellinghieri Esq. of the law firm MacElree Harvey Ltd., who introduced her to the Chester County Community Foundation as a trusted partner to carry out her legacy intentions. Joe’s connection to the Community Foundation complements MacElree Harvey’s approach to thoughtful, comprehensive legal counsel.

In their planning, Sue and Joe worked closely with the Community Foundation to establish the testamentary Barber Family Legacy Fund for Chester County, naming the Community Foundation as beneficiary of the remainder of the estate after her son’s passing.

Being so deeply connected with what she experienced throughout her life, Sue directed that the charitable fund benefit underprivileged children, at-risk youth, and special needs individuals in Chester County, promoting dignity and opportunity for all.

Sue passed in 2017 at the age of 97, living a life in service to others and love for Barry. Sue had to navigate unique circumstances, constantly advocating for her son. No doubt, she found her role to be challenging and deeply rewarding; and filled with unexpected moments of joy, humor, resilience, and unconditional love.



Barry spent his final years at Harston Hall in Flourtown, PA, where he was treated with the kindness and dignity he deserved by his caregivers. He passed in 2023.

The 2025 Community Foundation Door Opener Award to Joe Bellinghieri Esq. of MacElree Harvey sheds light on this meaningful legacy gift that spans two generations. Door Openers are catalysts for change and good works in our community, with a vital role in guiding philanthropic legacy gifts.

“Helping clients make a difference beyond their lifetime is one of the most rewarding parts of what we do,” Joe explained. “The Chester County Community Foundation offers community-focused stewardship. It’s an easy option to present the Community Foundation as a legacy partner to charitably-inclined estate planning clients.”

Visionary Award

EMERITUS HON. DR. CLIFFORD E. DEBAPTISTE
VISIONARY AWARD EST. 2022

Anthony Stancato Jr.

The Visionary Award shines a light on community leaders who empower others to be the change they wish to see in the world. These servants of the community are **Bridge Builders, Door Openers and Visionaries.**



At age 101, the Emeritus Hon. Dr. Clifford E. DeBaptiste chose the 2025 Visionary Award winner: **Anthony Stancato Jr.** "Anthony embodies the very essence of this award," exclaimed Hon. Dr. DeBaptiste. "His vision, expertise, and ability to get things done set a powerful example. Over the decades, he has earned the reputation of positively transforming the region."

Anthony remembers being particularly inspired by an outing to Washington, DC in the 1980s. "I was enjoying a wonderful afternoon in Georgetown, visiting the shops, noticing the mixed housing, and savoring the wonderful quandary of deciding where to eat supper and what to drink. It suddenly hit me that West Chester could be like this. We are the county seat, with a terrific hospital and university. We, too, could be vital, full of life, and full of options! And I'm a real estate developer! So, what would it take to do this?"

What it took was trusted colleagues, investors, persistence and continued inspiration over time.

In 1994, after working independently for 20 years as successful real estate developers, life-long Chester County residents and entrepreneurs Anthony Stancato Jr. and Victor Abdala Jr. founded StanAb Development Company. They intentionally focused on re-purposing under-utilized real estate to create positive economic impact in the community.

In 1994, Mayor DeBaptiste was elected West Chester's first black mayor. He recalls, "Community economic development is not the type of thing a person does alone. We had a great team—Anthony, Victor Abdala, Charlie Swope, Brian McFadden, Oscar Lasko, Jack Loew, Eli Kahn—we all worked together, over many, many, MANY years."

The main attraction, or "the magnet" as Anthony explains, is West Chester's most famous corner of High and Gay streets. Clifford and Anthony remember their frustration that this corner always seemed deserted: three almost empty buildings and the tenaciously enduring Rite Aid drugstore.



Anthony recalls, "We were finally able to persuade two 80-year old cousins from Bryn Mawr to let us buy the old Woolworth's Building from them. It took a lot of convincing because their long-term capital gains taxes would be so high. But we came up with a satisfactory solution. Then we renovated the upstairs for StanAb's offices and set our minds to figuring out what would be best for the downstairs."

Once again, Anthony's inspiration came over a good meal. "In 1996, we went to this new 'brewpub' place that had just opened in Newark, DE. People went CRAZY. Local beer brewed ten feet from your table. Fresh food made from scratch every day. Inspired recipes. People literally ate it up. I knew we needed an Iron Hill at High and Gay. We started to recruit Kevin Finn. We were persistent."

In 1998, Iron Hill opened its second location in West Chester: on the day of the Restaurant Festival. The crowd was so large that Iron Hill needed to close for the few days after, to regain inventory and catch their breath.

Iron Hill was so popular that people couldn't get in. Anthony explains why that's good: "A rising tide lifts all boats. If the wait at one place is always too long, then more places are motivated to open." Dr. DeBaptiste underscores the impact: "When I was mayor from 1994 to 2002, the number of restaurants in the borough grew from 15 to 57. Today, there are more than 85. We propelled downtown West Chester's economic and cultural renaissance."

StanAb is credited as a catalyst for the revitalization of downtown West Chester. By the time StanAb closed its doors three decades later, StanAb completed over 23 significant residential and commercial real estate projects in Chester County. Over the course of his career, Anthony played a pivotal role in shaping the physical and economic landscape of the region, transforming underutilized properties into vibrant hubs of residential, commercial, and cultural activity.

"Victor and I had a goal to wrap things up in 2021," said Anthony. "We set the date together. My stroke and the pandemic hurried things along for us. It was a good partnership and still a great friendship," says Tony. "The hard part for a lot of folks is to know when to say 'when.'"

Anthony exemplifies the spirit of the Visionary Award and the enduring legacy of Dr. DeBaptiste: to be the change and to inspire others to do the same. **For Good. Forever.**



Fund Highlight

STANLEY'S DREAM CHARITABLE FUND EST. 2004

By the time he was in 7th grade, Stanley Austin Edwards Jr. had a strongly focused ambition: he dreamed of attending college. A gifted student and promising athlete who excelled in basketball, football and golf, Stanley was on a clear path to achieve his largest aspiration.



Everything changed for young Stan and his family when he was diagnosed with a cancerous brain tumor at age 12.

Stanley required complex surgery. Due to the location of his tumor, the surgery

to remove it resulted in the onset of learning disabilities and paralysis of his right arm and leg. This obviously made school much more difficult, and it forever prevented Stanley from participating in the many sports he loved.

Despite the obstacles, Stanley persevered towards his ultimate dream of attending college. After seeing the movie *Rudy*, the true story of a young man who beat insurmountable odds to attend and play football at the University of Notre Dame, Stanley resolved that he would not only attend college, but that he would attend Notre Dame.

But in 2001, the Edwards family learned that Stanley's tumor had returned. After enduring learning disabilities, permanent paralysis, chemotherapy, intense physical, occupational and speech therapy, and the eventual loss of his sight,

the cancer won. Stanley passed away in January of 2002 at age 14. He was a freshman at Henderson High School.

But more than what he had lost, his family remembers what he managed to courageously sustain: his wit and sense of humor. His hope and faith. His strength and dignity. His zest for life. His ability to inspire all who met him. And of course, they remember his dream.



Two years after Stan's passing, the Edwards family attended Alice Thomas' Annual Scholarship luncheon at Henderson High School. Hon. Dr. Clifford DeBaptiste attended that luncheon as well.

Soon after, Hon. Dr. DeBaptiste came to the Community Foundation and handed Business Affairs staff a brown briefcase. It was filled with cash and change. Hon. Dr. DeBaptiste explained: "Mrs. Alice Thomas passed around a hat so people could donate in memory of Stanley Austin Edwards Jr. We want the Community Foundation to create a charitable fund. His parents will get involved after a while, when they are ready. The family has been through the wringer. But this will help them do good despite such a tragedy."

Donna Edwards clarified: "At the luncheon, I had mentioned to Mrs. Thomas that I'd love to establish a scholarship in Stanley's memory. So, she made an announcement and people donated whatever they wanted to. Dr. DeBaptiste stood up and made a very large donation. He told us that he would be in touch with the Community Foundation to get us started and support us along the way."

The Edwards family decided that Stanley's Dream would have two parts: to award college scholarships to Chester County high school graduating seniors; and to award grants for childhood brain cancer research.



Since 2004, Stanley's Dream has awarded \$110,000 in scholarships to 58 dreamers. These Chester County high school seniors have attended an array of universities including Cheyney, Cornell, Drexel, Duke, Howard, Johns Hopkins, Kutztown, Notre Dame, Penn State, Temple, Thaddeus Stevens and West Chester.

Stanley's Dream has granted \$140,000 to the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia Neuro-Oncology research program and similar causes. "Being able to donate to the same program that little Stan went through helps us keep his memory alive," explained Donna and

Stan. "Although Stan's outcome wasn't what we wanted, helping other families by giving scholarships and research grants continues his legacy and dream fulfilling us."

The Edwards family and friends continue to hold events to commemorate Stanley's Dream and raise funds for scholarship awards and grants. The annual New Year's Day 5K Walk/Run and summer Golf Classic attract hundreds of supporters.

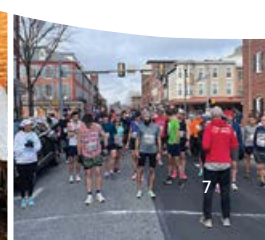

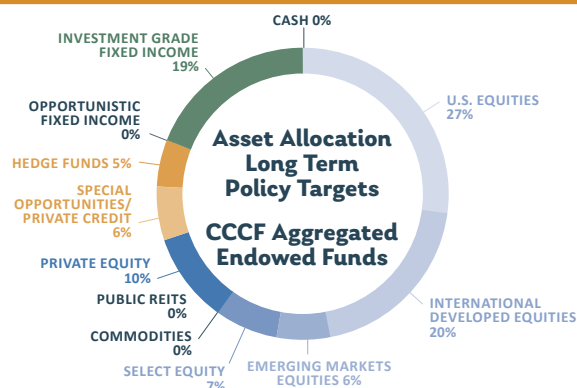

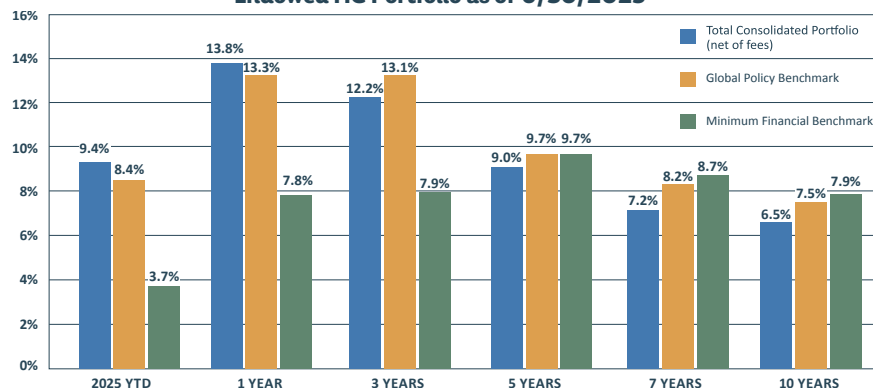

SEPARATELY MANAGED INVESTED ASSETS

The Medallion Investment program gives you the opportunity to establish a donor advised fund at the Foundation, while having a qualified advisor you choose continue to manage the asset and receive investment management fees.

- Medallion status is awarded to investment firms which pass an annual due diligence review undertaken by the Foundation's Investment team.
- Medallion funds are separately managed, non-aggregated funds, which receive their own investment return.
- The minimum amount to start a fund in the Medallion program is \$250,000 with the intent to grow to at least \$1 million within a few years.
- The minimum for non-Medallion investment partner program funds is \$25,000.
