## **“DARE TO DECLARE” MINI GRANT APPLICATION**

Kennett Collaborative seeks Dare to Declare mini-grant support to present a community-driven Dare to Declare celebration during June’s Third Thursday event in downtown Kennett Square. As the coordinating organization, Kennett Collaborative will partner with local community organizations and businesses to create an inclusive public program that invites residents and visitors to engage with the Declaration of Independence as a living document. Building on our broader America250 downtown beautification and enhanced marketing efforts, this event will activate a highly visible public space and encourage reflection on liberty, equality, and civic voice in a welcoming, accessible setting.

The Dare to Declare celebration will be integrated into an existing, well-attended community gathering, ensuring broad participation from families, children, longtime residents, and first-time visitors. Our goal is to have costumed actors from Kennett Amateur Theatrical Society present public readings that bring historical language to life, while the Lenape Brass Band, or similar, will provide live patriotic music that animates the downtown and creates a shared, celebratory atmosphere. Interactive children’s activities will offer young participants meaningful, age-appropriate ways to explore themes of freedom, expression, and civic participation.

Community collaboration is central to this effort. In addition to local shops and restaurants, Kennett Collaborative will coordinate with organizations including the Kennett Library, YMCA of Greater Brandywine, Kennett Heritage Center, the Kennett Square Juneteenth Committee, Kennett Underground Railroad Center, and others, to participate in the event and share how their America250 programs and perspectives contribute to a broader understanding of American history and freedom. Coordinated promotion through Kennett Collaborative’s marketing channels will highlight Dare to Declare alongside other America250 events taking place throughout the town, helping attendees connect with additional opportunities for learning and civic engagement.

Kennett Collaborative anticipates spending approximately \$2,500 overall on Dare to Declare activities at June’s Third Thursday, including performance stipends, youth programming supplies, sound equipment, plus additional event marketing and promotions.

Together, these partnerships transform a familiar downtown gathering into a shared community expression of America250—one that elevates multiple voices, encourages participation and dialogue, and strengthens connections between residents, organizations, and the enduring ideals of the nation’s founding.
